Activity 1

This is a managerial/problem solving activity where students work in small teams to design a city environment

Activity 2

These are 2 technical activities one of which is using a computer program to design a bridge, and the other is to learn by using instruments how engineers and surveyors work out the level of the land

Activity 3

This is a practical activity in which students will build houses and learn how architects design modern living environments for sustainable communities

We ask that schools send students who would benefit from this type of learning. Students should be from both genders and may be interested in developing a career in this employment sector via the CBE Diploma or other course of technical study that would lead to higher education.

We ask that a teacher accompanies each team.
Lunches will be provided.
