

PROGRAMS REPORT FOR FYE 8-31-25

Professional Development for Educators

LinkED conducted the following educator/parent/student training sessions for **236** individuals (**225** unduplicated) in the Tarrant County community:

1. Presented **Dr. Karen Young** training **Big Feelings. Big Behavior** to **42** area educators in November of 2024.
2. Conducted an educator workshop **Classroom Accommodation** to **12** teachers at St. George Catholic School in November of 2024.
3. Conducted an educator workshop **Cognitive Processes and Academic Learning** to **97** educators from the Fort Worth Diocese in February of 2025.
4. Presented an educator workshop **Learner Anxiety** to **27** teachers at St. Joseph Catholic School in March of 2025.
5. Presented **Dr. Crystal Collier** workshop on **Neuroscience of Screens** to **54** educators at Key School in August of 2025.
6. Presented **College Success Workshop** to **4** TCU students in August of 2025.

Educational Evaluation Program and Support Services

7. Provided **448** multiple evaluation services for **302** unduplicated children and adults. Evaluation services included neuroeducational assessments and achievement evaluations, ADHD evaluations, autism evaluations, cognitive ability assessments, psychological consultations, career assessments (Highlands Ability Battery and CliftonStrengths), and speech-language services. Children from 2-17: 72%, Age 18-adult: 28%. Male: 51%, Female: 49%. Evaluation Services Program clients in LinkED/TLCNT's history: **6,496**
8. Provided evaluation sliding scale financial support for **119** clients thanks to generous grant contributions from area foundations and individuals.
9. Received a **ninth** year of grant support in December 2024 from The Ryan Foundation to partner with local nonprofit agencies in Tarrant County in referring needed educational assessments for area children and youth from families with financial need.



Adult Services

10. Secured a **twelfth**-year grant through the Texas Workforce Commission, in cooperation with the Tarrant County Adult Education and Literacy Consortium, to provide learning disability services for adult students including screening assessments for learning disabilities and financial support for evaluations needed for formal accommodations on high school equivalency tests. In total, **33** adult learners were served with screening, mentoring, and coaching, **20** of which received diagnostic evaluations and psychological consultations free of charge. Of those learners served, **80** academic coaching sessions were performed that included screening services, testing referral completion, and classroom interventions.
11. Provided consultation services to adult education teachers and program social workers.
12. Represented LinkED as active members of the Tarrant County Adult Education and Literacy Consortium as well as the Workforce Development Board.
13. Worked closely with the sub-grantee programs (directors, staff, and teachers), providing support via presentations and referrals.
